PINEAPPLE DAY

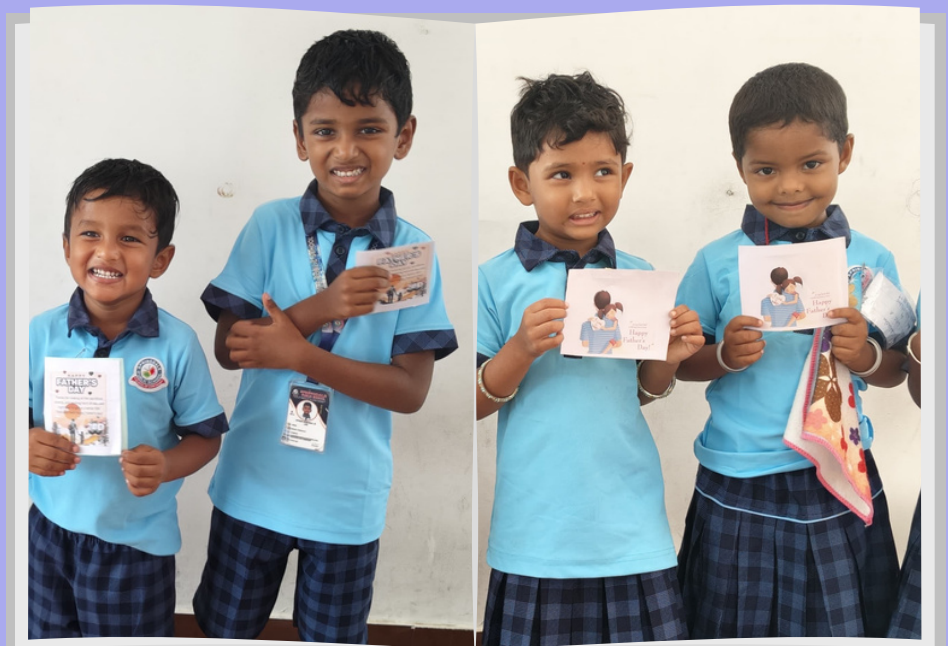
